The Anger of the Lord Was Kindled

Exodus 4:14 And the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> against Moses, and he said, *Is* not Aaron the Levite your brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he comes forth to meet thee: and when he sees you, he will be glad in his heart.

- Numbers 11:10 Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> greatly; Moses also was displeased.
- Numbers 12:9 And the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> against them; and he departed. Numbers 25:3 And Israel joined himself unto Baalpeor: and the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> against Israel.
- Deuteronomy 29:27 And the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book:
- Joshua 7:1 But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> against the children of Israel.
- 2 Samuel 6:7 And the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> against Uzzah; and God smote him there for *his* error; and there he died by the ark of God.
- 2 Samuel 24:1 And again the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.
- 2 Kings 13:3 And the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> against Israel, and he delivered them into the hand of Hazael king of Syria, and into the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael, all *their* days.
- 1 Chronicles 13:10 And the <u>anger of the LORD</u> was <u>kindled</u> against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God.
- 2 Chronicles 25:15 Wherefore the <u>anger of the LORD was kindled</u> against Amaziah, and he sent unto him a prophet, which said unto him, Why hast thou sought after the gods of the people, which could not deliver their own people out of thine hand?
