- 9. Light and voice at Saul's conversion (9:1-9).
- 10. Saul blinded and healed (9:8-19).
- 11. Aeneas healed of paralysis (9:32-35).
- 12. Dorcas restored to life (9:36-41).
- 13. Herod's violent death (12:20-23).
- 14. Elymas the sorcerer blinded (13:6-11).
- 15. Cripple at Lystra healed (14:8-10).
- 16. Demons cast out of a slave girl (16:16-18).
- 17. Paul freed from prison by earthquake (16:25-27).
- 18. Eutychus raised from death (20:7-12).
