Application: Scriptures to Think About

Tension between Scripture, Politics and Culture

Three questions need to be answered as you read each Biblical truth:

- 1. What does it say? Say it in your own words
- 2. What does it mean for every believer?
- 3. How can I put it into practice in my life?
- Mt 22:21 Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's and to God the things that are His.
- John 18:36 "My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place."
- 1 John 2:15-17 <u>Love not the world</u>, neither the things in the world...If any man love the world the love of the Father is not in him.
- Romans 1:32 "Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them." Do we vicariously find pleasure in the sins of the world through the TV, internet, movies, and books we read?
- Romans 12:1-2"<u>Don't let the world squeeze you into its mold</u>." Be not conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.
- 2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore <u>come out from among them</u>, and <u>be separate</u>, says the Lord, and <u>touch not the unclean thing</u>; and I will receive you,
- Hebrews 11:10 ... of whom this world is not worthy, <u>They looked for a city whose builder and</u> maker is God.
- Hebrews 11:24-26 By faith Moses, when he was come to years, <u>refused to</u> be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; <u>Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season</u>; Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward.
- Hebrews 12:3 KJV For consider him that endured such <u>contradiction of sinners</u> against himself, lest you be wearied and faint in your minds.
- 1 Peter 3:15 KJV But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asks you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear
