

What Do We Do?

We come alongside your pastor and congregation to preach, teach and train a “passion for prayer and the presence of God.” Our goal is to help you make your church a place of God’s manifest presence.

How Do We Do It?

Our primary desire is to come to your church for extended prayer weekends of intensive focus on and the presence of God through Sunday preaching, teaching seminars and training sessions. Then we partner with your pastor to coach, train and mentor him in becoming a praying pastor.

What Does it Cost?

The cost is two fold. First there is the cost of year long Prayer and Planning Retreat training for your pastor which is \$600 per year. Multiple staff pastors pay only \$300 each to cover expenses. We are willing to come to any church on a specified “freewill offering” basis without any specified honorarium.

When Can We Come?

We are able to come for a single Sunday of preaching to introduce our ministry and passion to the whole congregation. That can be scheduled as soon as you express and interest, the sooner the better since we have only about 32 weeks available per year. July and August are not good months for this ministry.

Q&A

1. Can I as a pastor receive the coaching without the church partnership? Yes, we would be delighted to coach you for the year even if your church is not ready, able or willing to partner with us at this time.
2. Can we invite you for a preaching/teaching weekend without our pastor entering into the coaching program? Yes, but with the understanding by the church that you cannot expect that an outside voice will effect permanent change if the pastor does not change his prayer and ministry habits.
3. We are a small church (under 100) would you be willing to come to our church? Perhaps. We are not doing this for the money but to help churches and pastors. We are willing to talk with your church elders and/or board about other arrangements if you are really motivated to do this partnership.
4. Would you be able to shorten this partnership to just two weekends instead of three during the year? Yes, provided it does not hinder other churches from scheduling a partnership. A two weekend campaign has less of an impact that the extended times together but yes, we can do just the two intense weekends.
5. What would be the price for doing a two weekend campaign? *We are always willing to come on a specified freewill offering basis plus the cost of travel, food and lodging.* Let's talk about this possibility.
6. Can we schedule a one-weekend of intensive teaching-preaching instead of the partnership? Yes, that is possible and one of the options presented in our brochure. It will be contingent on the pastor and elders being willing to invest time and effort in pre-planning and promoting this special weekend. *We are always willing to come on a specified freewill offering basis. Let's talk about this possibility.*
7. Can you come to our church for one Sunday as pulpit supply? Not normally. But if I have a free Sunday I'd love to preach in your church. Just ask. I do not usually do pulpit supply for two reasons: 1) I reserve my schedule for churches wanting the full ministry. 2) I cannot build a significant relationship with the pastor or church in one service and expect a lasting impact. There are lots of other pulpit suppliers available. At this time I am not one of them.
